Eligibility

- Must be a Washington resident and register the vehicle with the Department of Licensing at a Washington residential address.
- Purchase or lease an eligible EV from a participating dealer.
- Meet income eligibility requirements below.

Either have a combined household income at or below the levels shown in this table, or be enrolled in one of the following income-qualified programs:

2	\$61,320
3	\$77,460
4	\$93,600
5	\$109,740
6	\$125,880
