
EasySteps to Paying with CheckFreePay

Pay your utility bill in-person with CheckFreePay! CheckFreePay allows you to pay your bill in the way that's most convenient for you, including with cash. Here's how:

Bring your utility invoice to a local CheckFreePay location that accepts payment by account number. Use this link to find a location near you. Go to the service counter and let the attendant know you'd like to pay your utility bill.



Provide the attendant with the following information:

- Your name, address, and your full account number including any numbers after the dash (Note: The attendant may ask for your ID during the payment process).
- The utility company name on your invoice.
- The 9-digit remittance zip code located on your invoice.



Make your payment (including the location surcharge) and collect your receipt as proof of payment.

NOTE: If you are currently past due and making an in-person payment to satisfy a disconnection, please contact the Customer Service number on your invoice.
